

Colorado State Thespians Main Stage Application Form

Interested in presenting on the main stage at the Colorado State Thespian Conference, here is the information we need in order to schedule a screening of your production. (One Acts are registered through the Colorado Individual Events Showcase process inside the Troupe Registration on-line at www.cothespians.com.)

Shows are selected on a first-come-first-serve basis. Colorado State Thespians will only screen shows in the fall of the current academic school year, Colorado State Thespians selects two shows from the academic educational theatre arena, and both high school and college shows are screened until two shows are selected for the conference. For consideration for screening, schools must be registered for the conference with all cast and crew members listed in their online registration.

Performance Venue: Colorado Convention Center, Auditorium Stage, a proscenium theatre 100' * 25' to the cyclorama. There is a large apron that adds depth to the stage, creating a semi-thrust; this area is only available for a Friday night production, unless set pieces can be moved relatively quickly during the Thursday night 15 minute intermission. There is an underground three semi-truck loading dock, numerous dressing rooms and a green room available stage right. Each school is given a load-in and set-up from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., this includes rehearsal time and additional time may be booked and paid for by the individual performance group. Colorado State Thespians uses union technicians, thus union breaks and rules apply. Nothing can be attached to the stage or walls at the Colorado Convention Center, all sets must be self-bracing. In addition to this form schools must submit a lighting plot with all specials noted and a ground plan of their set. Pictures of the set should be included in an attachment email to jay@cothespians.com. Colorado State Thespians provides basic sound equipment, but additional UHF microphones are up to the individual school. Royalties must be paid by the school performing, royalty waiver forms can be found at EDTA.org.
